National Statistics Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic

It's an authorized body responsible for **statistics of mutual and foreign trade** of goods and preparation of information on foreign trade of the nation.

Regulation of the Cabinet #470 of 20 August 2014 "On organizing and conducting in Kyrgyzstan statistics on mutual trade of goods with member countries of the Customs Union and statistics on foreign trade of goods with third countries"



Action plan of organizing statistical recording of volumes of mutual trade of Kyrgyzstan with member countries of the Eurasian Economic Union in November-December 2014 and 2015"

Order of the National Statistics Committee #96 of 16 December 2014

- Form #1 – Mutual Trade "Report on mutual trade with member countries of the Eurasian Economic Union" (monthly).
Applicable for legal persons and individuals.
- Making a list of entities involved in foreign trade with EAEU countries based on analyzing the database of foreign trade over the last 3 years
- Consultations with respondents
- Collecting data on Form 1 – Mutual Trade from April to July 2015 in order to compare with the database of cargo declarations of the State Customs Service

Action plan for November-December 2014 and 2015

Order of the National Statistics Committee #96 of 16 December 2014

- Information campaign among respondents:
 - Speaking on TV
 - Publications in mass media
 - Information boards and posters in all city and district departments of NSC
- Changes in organizational structure of NSC: responsible units were defined in territorial divisions of NSC
- Changes in information collection procedure and information processing software
- Training specialists of regional statistics divisions
- A number of events conducted with State Tax Service (STS) and State Customs Service to reach maximum number of respondents
- Since August 2015 – monthly selective examination of individuals to study movement of goods through 7 border crossing points between Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan



Selective examination of individuals

Methodological regulation for conducting selective examination of individuals on border crossing points between Kyrgyzstan and Kazakhstan.

Approved by a regulation of the Board of the National Statistics Committee #22 of 28 July 2015

The object of statistical examination are individuals moving goods in big volumes by vehicles.

Periodicity: monthly

Time of examinations: at daytime at 09:00-18:00, at nighttime at 20:00-08:00

Duration of examination: 7 days

Days of examination: according to a schedule, including weekdays and weekend

- Memorandum between the National Statistics Committee of Kyrgyzstan and the Statistics Committee of the Ministry of the National Economy of Kazakhstan on exchange of statistical information on mutual trade of 19 May 2015.
- Memorandum between the Federal Customs Service of Russia and the National Statistics Committee of Kyrgyzstan on exchange of statistical information on mutual trade – at the stage of approval since September 2016

Measures to improve statistical coverage

1. Data of the State Tax Service for Jan-Dec 2015 and Jan-Jun 2016 about importers and exporters in EAEU countries
2. Comparison with data of current state statistical observations and identification of a list of economic entities that have not reported
3. Bilateral comparison of data on selected goods with specialists of the Federal Customs Service of Russia (in Bishkek)
4. Bilateral comparison of data on selected goods with specialists of the National Statistical Committee of Belarus, Statistics Committee of Kazakhstan and Statistics Agency of Armenia



Tasks

1. Access to **primary administrative data** of state bodies of Kyrgyzstan: State Registration Service, State Tax Service, Ministry of Transport and Roads, Ministry of Agriculture, Food Industry and Melioration, State Inspectorate of Environmental and Technical Safety, etc. (December 2016 – conclusion of bilateral agreements on information exchange)
2. Conduction of monthly round-the-clock selective examinations of individuals over 7 days on border crossing points (extra financial and human resources are needed)
3. Development of new software for processing, comparing, analyzing and distributing statistical data on foreign trade and mutual trade (1st quarter of 2017 using a Russian grant)
4. Development of methodology of statistics on mutual trade (based on recommendations of Eurasian Economic Commission, ADB project, experience of EAEU countries)
5. Capacity building and skills development of specialists of the National Statistics Committee (training and experience exchange are needed but no resources!)
